Educational Tour on Tristan the Tractor

Educational Programme - KS1 & KS2

The educational activities, led by our experienced guides are tailor-made to meet the needs of **KS1** and **KS2**.

You can choose two of the following programmes as part of your visit together with a mix of adventure play:

- **Caring for Animals** – Whether on the farm or pets in the home, animals have the same five basic needs: food, water, shelter, space and companionship. Learn how we should look after them. (Science, Citizenship)
- **Farm to Fork** – Collect a basket of food from our Farm Shop and match the items with the plants and animals you'll see on the farm. Make a real connection between the food we eat and how it grows. (Science, Geography, PSHE)
- **Growing** – See how crops and vegetables grow at Hatton's award-winning Growing Patch. Make a recycled pot, sow some seeds and take them back to school to watch them grow. (Science, PSHE)
- **Natural Environment** – Recognise different habitats and identify some of the plants and animals living in our woods and hedgerows. Learn how farmers encourage wildlife in the countryside. (Science)
- **Variation** – Animals have evolved to suit their environment and way of life. Make observations and comparisons of Hatton's huge variety of breeds. Includes an interactive falconry display. (Science)
- **Growth and Change** – Make observations and comparisons of Hatton's wide variety of animals at different stages of their life. Relate these observations to lifecycles. (Science, Citizenship, PSHE)
